## **Official Sentenced For Taking Payoffs**

John Cassiliano, a New York City sanitation official who was dismissed after being convicted of taking payoffs from toxic-waste dumpers, was sentenced yesterday to one to three years in prison and fined \$5,000.

He also received a one-year sentence, to be served concurrently, for official misconduct in allowing unauthorized chemical dumping at the Brookfield landfill on Staten Island between 1977 and 1979.

Mr. Cassiliano was convicted Nov. 11 after a three-week jury trial on Staten Island before State Supreme Court Justice Louis Sangiorgio, who also sentenced him.
